

Athlete Guide – 2018 Resolution Run 5K

1. The 2018 Resolution Run 5K is closed out! There is no Raceday registration.
2. Be at the Hillsborough Municipal Building (379 So. Branch Rd 08844) starting at 9:30 am to pick up Bib (with attached timing chip), goody bag and hoody.
3. Carpool if you can. Park in legal spots only. We have permission to park in any legal spot around the building including the Library and Playground areas. Do not park on So. Branch Rd or Beekman Ln. Police will be enforcing regulations. Lots of parking on surrounding streets but allow enough time to get your stuff and return to car.
4. Please bring non-perishable food item, cleaning or toiletry item Food Bank collection. Drop off area will be marked inside Multi-Purpose Room.
5. Bib pickup area is arranged alphabetically to your left as you enter the Multi-Purpose Room from the main hallway. You will get your bib with attached timing tag and pins for your bib. Move on to the goody bag and hoody pickup areas.
6. Hoody Size. The size you requested is marked on your bib. Please do not ask for a different size; Volunteers cannot change sizes.
7. The bib number must be placed facing the front at belt level or above.
8. Bathrooms located inside Municipal Bldg.
9. Follow instructions given on loudspeaker. Line-up outside Library about 10 minutes before 11:00 am start.
10. Faster runners line up near front. Slower runners and walkers please stay further back.
11. Race Director will give final instructions.
12. Commands will be “Ready. Start”
13. No water stops on course due to cold weather and distance. If you feel you may need to drink or eat, please bring what you need.
14. No “Bandits” please. If you are not registered, stay off the course! Do not cross Finish Line. It ruins the timing! This race is timed according to “Gun Time,” which is the actual time between when we all start and when YOU finish.
15. Mile 1 and Mile 2 will have Volunteers to call out the time.
16. Other Volunteers are located at every major turn. Course is marked with arrows and cones. It is OK to thank our Volunteers!
17. Run in “safe mode;” in the parts of the course where we share the road.
18. Be courteous to any vehicles you see. They probably belong to residents who live along the course. You can wish them a “Happy New Year,” but please defer to them.
19. After crossing Finish, receive your Ribbon and proceed to Multi-Purpose Room for water, pretzels and fruit. Please keep food line moving; save some for later Finishers.
20. U.S. Candidids will be taking photos throughout the morning. You will get an email in a day or two when photos are ready. Check anytime at www.uscandidids.com

22. Awards and Random Prizes will take place in Multi-Purpose Room starting at approximately 12:00 noon. First, second and third overall prizes are given, followed by awards 3 deep in five year age groups beginning at 9 and Under, 10-14, 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79 and 80+. In addition, first Masters (40 and over) are awarded. Prizes are given for Most Original, Most Funny and Most Sincere Resolutions. There may be other categories.
23. Look for the Race Expo near the Volunteer Desk. 2017 hoodies (\$10 each) are available while they last! Runner’s Gloves (\$2 a pair). Cash or check only.
24. Results will be live. See your preliminary results on your smart phone shortly after you finish at: live.compuscore.com Look online (www.resolutionrun.org or www.compuscore.com) Monday afternoon for full results.
